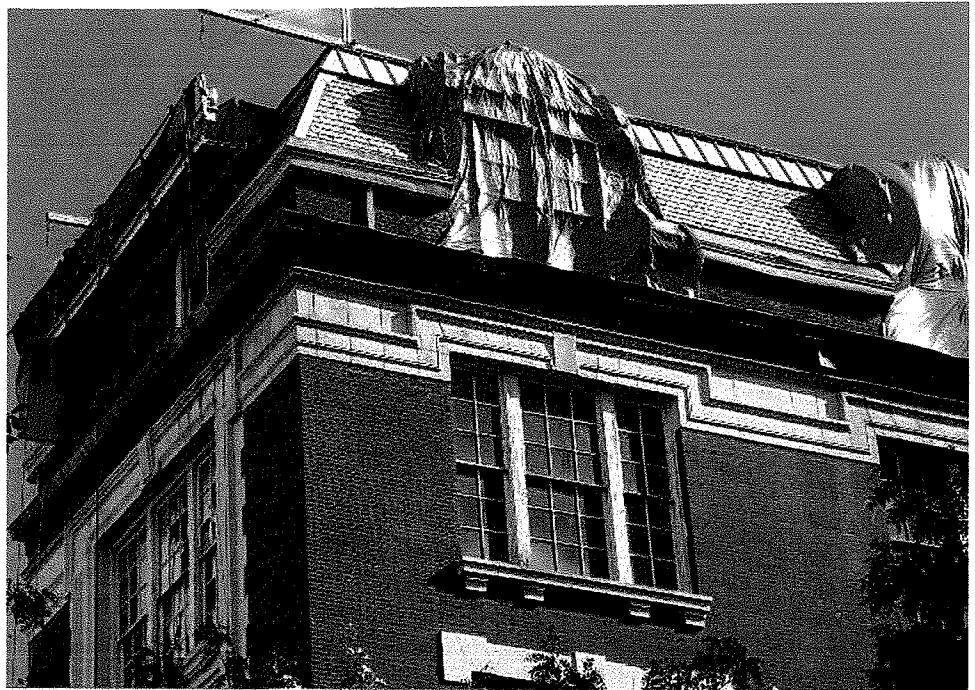


PRESS CONFERENCE

**Save the Landmarked Former Charas/PS 64
Monday, March 9th, 5:30 PM
East 10th Street Between Avenue B & C**

Please join us at a press conference on Monday, March 9th at 5:30 P.M. to call for an end to the neglect and decay of this historic East Village landmark. The owner, who has lost several court battles to overturn landmark designation, has removed historic details from the building and left it open and exposed to the elements. The Landmarks Preservation Commission (LPC) has called upon the building owner to seal the building, but he has thus far refused; the LPC can levy fines against the owner, but has not yet.



Join us as we call upon the owner to live up to his responsibility to maintain this precious historic resource, and to the City to take decisive action to force him to do so.
