Come to the Presentation of the City's Plans on Thursday, June 9

On June 9, the City will present its draft downzoning and landmarking plans for the Far West Village, which will make some critical, long-overdue changes to protect the scale and character of this neighborhood. **BUT WE ARE CONCERNED THAT THE PLAN MAY ALSO INCLUDE CARVE-OUTS ALLOWING SOME HUGE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENTS TO MOVE AHEAD, AND MAY FAIL TO PROTECT SOME KEY HISTORIC SITES.**

Let the City know that you support changes moving ahead **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**, but that **LANDMARKING AND DOWNZONING PLANS FOR THE FAR WEST VILLAGE MUST BE COMPREHENSIVE AND PROVIDE PROTECTIONS FOR THE ENTIRE NEIGHBORHOOD!**

- **COME TO THE HEARING ON JUNE 9 at 6:30 pm at 32 Waverly Place (east of Wash. Sq. Pk.) rm. 703 (bring ID to enter)**; the Chairs of the New York City Planning Commission and Landmarks Preservation Commission will be there to present their draft plans, answer questions, and get feedback from the public. Urge **NO CARVE OUTS** and **NO DELAYS!**
